UPDATED IOLA ISD COVID-19 QUARANTINE GUIDANCE

Dear Iola Secondary Parents, Guardians, Faculty and Staff

August 23, 2022

In keeping with Iola ISD's practices to respond to COVID-19, we are notifying all parents, guardians, faculty and staff of Iola Independent School District's updated COVID-19 guidelines. The new guidelines are as follows:

Staff who are positive:

- Staff may return to school when at least 5 days have passed since onset of symptoms, fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication, and symptoms are improving.
- If asymptomatic and test positive, must remain at home 5 days post positive test date.

Students who are positive:

- Students may return to school when at least 5 days have passed since onset of symptoms, fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication, and symptoms are improving.
- If asymptomatic and test positive, must remain at home 5 days post positive test date.

Staff or students with symptoms who do not test:

- Students or staff who are ill with COVID-19 like symptoms, who do not test, must remain at home until fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication and have improving symptoms.

Student and Staff Close Contact (meaning a household member is positive):

- We ask that you quarantine any infected household member away from those in the house, as much as possible. If you start to have symptoms, please stay home until you have met the above criteria.
