## 2022 – 2023 IHS Senior Parking Spot Agreement

Seniors who have completed the following may participate in the painting of their assigned parking space:

- **Submit a sketch** of your parking space design before you begin painting your spot.
- Parking spot agreement form will need to be turned in on the day that you are reserving your Senior Parking Spot.
- Pay a **\$20 deposit**. This deposit is to guarantee the painting over of your parking spot at the end of the school year. This money will be returned to you if/when you paint back over your spot at the end of the school year. If you do not paint over your parking spot, this deposit will be donated to a school club/organization which will paint back over your parking spot for you.

Students are reminded that all student code of conduct and all local laws will be enforced regarding the Senior Parking Space Personalization process. Wording or marks of alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia, slander, slang, racism, gangs, or sexual connotation will lead to loss of privilege and/or punishment. At any time during the year, IHS reserves the right to remove the Senior Parking Space Painting privilege if any of the above occurs. All paint, supplies, and clean-up are the responsibility of the student. (Iola ISD provides the black paint used at the end of the school year to black out the parking spot.)

# Iola High School Senior Parking

**Seniors!!! You can reserve and paint your very own parking spot for the 2022 - 2023 school year!**

If you are a Senior for the 2022 – 2023 school year and wish to have a RESERVED parking spot, you must:

- Complete a Senior Parking Design Request
- Complete a Senior Parking Spot Agreement
- All designs must be completed, and submitted for review on or before you begin.
- Pay a **\$20 deposit** to guarantee the painting over of your parking spot at the end of the school year. (This is refunded if you repaint your spot. If not, a school club/org will paint it for \$20.)

If you wish to drive a vehicle to school you must register for a student parking permit for the 2022 – 2023 school year.

*Keep in mind all student code of conduct and all local laws will be enforced regarding the personalization process. Wording or marks of alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia, slander, slang, racism, gangs, or sexual connotation will lead to loss of privilege and/or punishment. At any time during the year, the IHS administrative team reserves the right to remove the Senior Parking Space Painting privilege if any of the above occurs.*

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## ***Painting of Senior Parking Spaces 2022 – 2023:***

Seniors will be painting their parking spaces from July 26th through August 7th.

In order to follow all county and district codes, please note the guidelines below that must be followed for the painted parking spaces and sign stating that you will oblige and understand that if the guidelines aren't followed your privileges will be revoked.

- Students must keep a 4" unpainted border between the yellow parking space lines and the paint in their parking spot. (Please use blue painters tape)
- Students who are approved for painting a parking space must select an outlined space on the attached parking lot diagram.
- Any artwork depicting items, symbols, or language that IHS administration deems inappropriate will not be allowed.

**Students driving to school must have a IHS parking permit, present a current TX driver's license and valid insurance, and have a license plate number to reserve a parking spot. All designs must be completed on the Senior Parking Design Request form and returned to the front office for approval by Mrs. Darby or Mr. Fowler.**

Your design should be clearly drawn on the following form and must include the colors you will be using on your parking space. On your design sheet, please include your first and last name, email address, and cell phone number where you can be reached. Once your design has been reviewed, Mrs. Darby or Mr. Fowler will let you know if any changes need to be made.

## **STUDENT PARKING SPACE RULES**

1. You **MUST** purchase your own paint. (It takes gallons per spot, not quarts.)
2. Do not cover parking lines or numbers
3. Student must clean spills and must discard all unused materials
4. All parking spots will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. **You must be in person to reserve your spot. There will be no “reserving spots” for other students.**
5. **HAVE FUN**; the purpose of allowing students to paint their own parking spot is aimed at improving school pride and camaraderie. Students can "own" a piece of the school for a year. We encourage students to express themselves through positive artwork.
6. **Paint your name (at least your first name) somewhere on your spot.** An **APPROPRIATE** nickname will be allowed.
7. Having students park in these reserved spots can also help identify unwelcome visitors to campus if they park in student spots.

All designs are due to Mrs. Darby or Mr. Fowler in the IHS front office. There will be time to review designs and communicate with seniors any of the changes that need to be made. Students may start dropping off design requests as early as Tuesday, July 26th, 2022 @ 9:00AM to the front office. If you have any questions, please contact the front office at 936-394-2361.

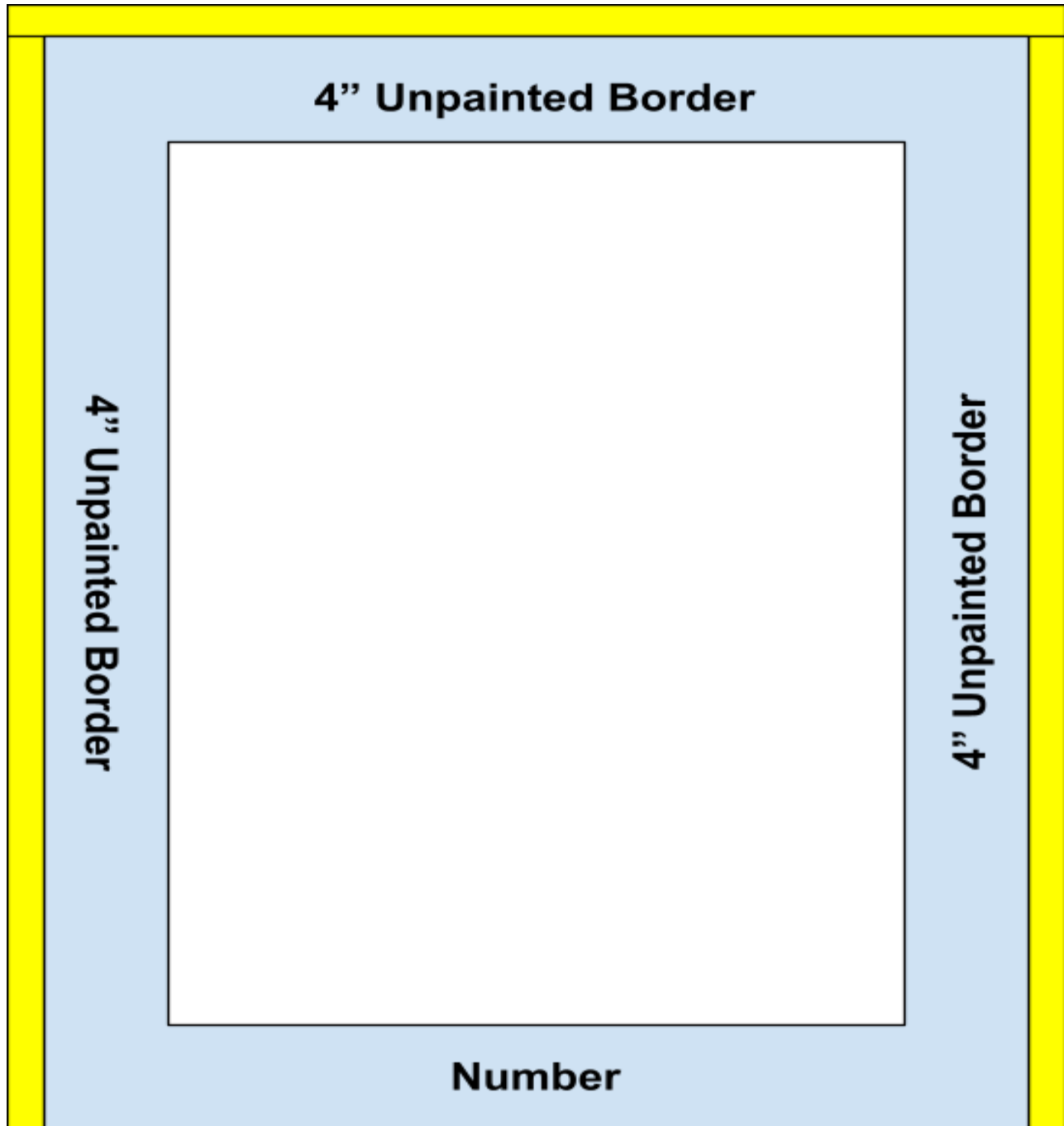
Remember, painting a student parking spot is completely optional. There will be parking available for students who do not wish to decorate a parking spot.

Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration. Loss of privilege or disciplinary action could result from displaying prohibited items. If this happens, you'll be forfeiting your right to a parking space and possibly to drive on campus.

# Senior Parking Design Request

This design sheet must be done in color and must represent exactly what will be painted on your parking space if it is accepted. **You may start submitting drawings at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 26, 2022. The deadline to submit drawings is Thursday, August 4, 2022 at 3:00 p.m.**

Parking spot painting is July 26th through August 7th.
