

Iola High School Senior Parking

Seniors!!! You can reserve and paint your very own parking spot for the 2021 - 2022 school year!

If you are a Senior for the 2021 – 2022 school year and wish to have a RESERVED parking spot, you must:

- Complete a Senior Parking Design Request
- Complete a Senior Parking Spot Agreement
- All designs must be completed, and submitted for review on or before you begin.
- Agree to paint over your spot with black paint before the 2021-2022 IHS Graduation.

If you wish to drive a vehicle to school you must register for a student parking permit for the 2021 – 2022 school year.

Keep in mind all social distancing rules, student code of conduct, and all local laws will be enforced regarding the personalization process. Wordings or marks of alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia, slander, slang, racism, gangs, or sexual connotation will lead to punishment and/or criminal action. At anytime during the year, the IHS administrative team reserves the right to remove the Senior Parking Space Painting privilege during the school year if any of the above occurs.

Painting of Senior Parking Spaces 2021 – 2022:

Seniors will be painting their parking spaces from July 28th through August 8th (Beginning at 7:00 AM).

In order to follow all county and district codes, please note the guidelines below that must be followed for the painted parking spaces and sign stating that you will oblige and understand that if the guidelines aren't followed your privileges will be revoked.

- **WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT** is the only type of paint that can be used.
- No reflective paint
- No spray paint
- No fluorescent paint
- Students must keep a 4" unpainted border between the yellow parking space lines and the paint in their parking spot. (Please use blue painters tape)
- Students who are approved for painting a parking space must select an outlined space on the attached parking lot diagram.
- Any artwork depicting items, symbols, or language that IHS administration deems inappropriate will not be allowed.

Students driving to school must have a IHS parking permit, present a current TX driver's license and valid insurance, and have a license plate number to reserve a parking spot. All designs must be completed on the Senior Parking Design Request form and returned to the front office for approval by Mrs. Darby or Mr. Fowler.

Your design should be clearly drawn on this form and must include the colors you will be using on your parking space. On your design sheet, please include your first and last name, email address, and cell phone number where you can be reached. Once your design has been reviewed, Mrs. Darby or Mr. Fowler will let you know if any changes need to be made.

STUDENT PARKING SPACE RULES

1. You **MUST** purchase your own paint. (It takes gallons per spot, not quarts.)
2. Do not cover parking lines or numbers
3. Student must clean spills and must discard all unused materials
4. All parking spots will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. **You must be in person to reserve your spot. There will be no "reserving spots" for other students.**
5. **HAVE FUN**; the purpose of allowing students to paint their own parking spot is aimed at improving school pride and camaraderie. Students can "own" a piece of the school for a year. We encourage students to express themselves through positive artwork.
6. **Paint your name (at least your first name) somewhere on your spot. An APPROPRIATE** nickname will be allowed.
7. Having students park in these reserved spots can also help identify unwelcome visitors to campus if they park in student spots.

All designs are due to Mrs. Darby or Mr. Fowler in the IHS front office. There will be time to review designs and communicate with seniors any changes that need to be made. Students may start dropping off design requests as early as Tuesday, July 27th, 2020 to the front office. If you have any questions, please contact the front office at 936-394-2361.

Remember, painting a student parking spot is completely optional. There will be parking available for students who do not wish to decorate a parking spot.

Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration. Disciplinary and/or criminal actions may be taken. If this happens, you'll be forfeiting your right to a parking space and/or to drive on campus.

- Agree to paint over your spot with black paint before the 2021-2022 IHS Graduation.

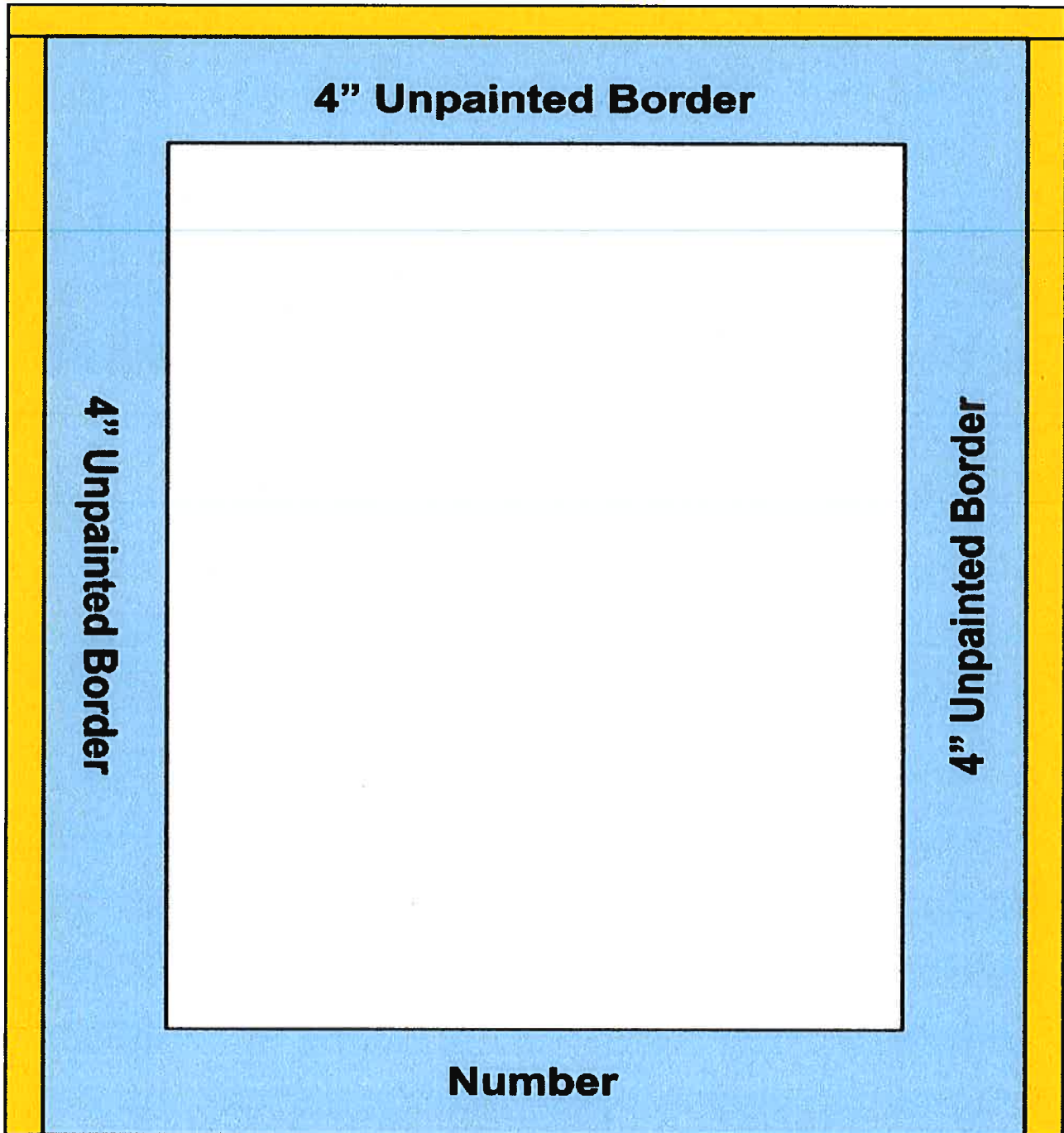
